In addition, as a guest performer, he was invited to participate in the Taichung International Jazz Festival in Taiwan and the Tainan Chiayi international wind Festival, and has toured Europe, Asia and other countries for many times, as well as undertaking major national performance tasks, including the "thousand symphonies" concert at Tiananmen Square in Beijing to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the founding of the people's Republic of China, and the tour of the five eastern European countries of the the Belt and Road, Greece, Bulgaria, Romania, Hungary and Serbia.
