

Charlotte began her musical journey at the young age of five. With a natural flair for the harp, she has already amassed an impressive array of accomplishments. As a two-time finalist (2021 and 2023) in the prestigious American Harp Society - National Harp Competition, Charlotte has demonstrated her commitment to excellence within the field.

In 2022, her dedication paid off as she earned first place in the Young Musician category at the American Protégé International Competition of Romantic Music. This triumph led to a coveted invitation to perform at the iconic Carnegie Hall. Further accolades followed, with Charlotte winning a Silver Medal at the 4th Vienna International Competition in 2022.

In 2023, Charlotte maintained her series of victories, clinching the top spot in the String Division at the San Diego Youth Protégé Competition. Furthermore, she triumphed in the Scandinavian Music Competition, Young Soloist International Music Competition, and the London International Music Competition. Her exceptional skills were further highlighted when she was inducted into the Advanced Orchestra of the Mainly Mozart Youth Orchestra for the same year—a remarkable feat considering she played in the Mainly Mozart Youth Orchestra at just 11 years old. The opportunity to play with the Mainly Mozart Youth Orchestra allowed her to perform at the Rady Shell in San Diego. In Late 2023 Charlotte also placed 2<sup>nd</sup> place the MMYO String Division Competition. Later in 2023 Charlotte continues to win awards. She won in World Classic Music Award with a Platinum position and then JSFest with 1<sup>st</sup> place award in Harp for Winter 2023.

Charlotte's accomplishments underscore her immense talent and burgeoning prominence in the classical music realm.
